Apparatus Operator – Aerial Device

This is a 24 hour course being held on the following dates:

May 17, 18, 30, 31 from 19:00 to 22:00 hours
May 27, & June 3 from 09:00 to 15:00 hours

Description: Designed to follow the NFPA 1002 Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator Professional Qualifications provides the student with knowledge necessary to operate, inspect and maintain aerial devices. Course content includes emergency vehicle operations review, classification and typing, vehicle inspection, operations of various types of aerial devices including platforms and ladders, proper location of placement and setup at an incident including driving, spotting and stabilizing. Fire departments must possess an aerial device to offer this program enabling students to fully operate this device.

Target audience: Fire Service Personnel.

Prerequisites: Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations (formerly known as Scene Support Operations) and Apparatus Operator: Emergency Vehicle Operations or equivalent.

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter on the first day of class. Class size is limited to Fifteen (15) students.

Venue: Westchester County DES Training Center, 4 Dana Rd. – Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York.
