PESH/OSHA Overview **Discussion of the OSHA Standards for the Fire Service**

Director, Division of Safety and Health, NYS Department of Labor

Dr. Franko has been working at DOL for five years. Her responsibilities include the Asbestos Control Bureau, Mold Licensing Program, On-Site Consultation, Boiler Safety, Public Employee Safety and Health, Engineering Services, and the Licensing and Certification Program. Prior to DOL she worked with the New York State Department of Health as the Director for the Bureau of Occupational Health. In addition, she was an Industrial Hygienist with the Albany Area Office for OSHA and prior to that a Sanitarian for the Albany County Department of Health. She has Masters Degrees in Public Health and Community Health Education and a Doctorate in Public Health from SUNY Albany School of Public Health. She received her undergraduate degree in Microbiology.
