Medium Level Structural Collapse Concepts

This is a 12 hour course being held on the following dates:

March 20, 21, & 28 from 18:30 to 22:30 hours

Description: This classroom program is designed to provide the background knowledge necessary to perform rescue operations at a structural collapse incident. The course includes instruction on: structural construction considerations such as types of construction, construction techniques, terminology, and mechanism of collapse based on structure type; detailed concepts of structural shoring systems; void search and rescue operations in structural collapse incidents; structural collapse team organization and operations concepts.

Target audience: Emergency response personnel with responsibility in structural collapse operations

Prerequisites: Basic Structural Collapse Operations

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Class size is limited to thirty (30) students.
