Back to Basics: Standpipe Operations

Description: This program will focus on Standpipe Operations and will cover the following topics:

- Alternate Water Supply Operations
- Lobby Control
- Elevator Use During Fires
- Stairwell Types and Designation for Operations
- Review of Types and Classes of Standpipe Systems
- Review of various Standpipe Hose/Nozzle Combinations
- Stretching and Advancing Hose Operations
- Alternate Tactics for Suppression
- Engine Company Emergencies for Standpipe Equipped Building

Prior to attending the training, all members are encouraged to locate Standpipe Equipped Buildings in their respective response areas or mutual aid response areas. Additionally, members should inventory their standpipe packs and be able to discuss the design and component parts.
