Pump Operator Refresher Training

This is a 6 hour course being held on the following dates:

June 11th from 19:00 to 22:00 hours

June 16th from 09:00 to 13:00 hours

Description: This class offers a detailed review of requisite knowledge that is fundamental to successful pump operation.

The class has been developed on objectives from NFPA; Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator and Chapter's 3 & 4 of the NYS Apparatus Operator–Pump course. The class covers fire service hydraulics and determining: pump discharge pressure, fire flow, and friction loss formulas respectively.

Course Requirements: A standalone calculator (no cell phone apps), pencil, and paper.

Target audience: Fire service personnel who are enrolled or planning on enrolling in the NYS Apparatus Operator–Pump course.

Prerequisites: Fire service personnel who are enrolled or planning on enrolling in the NYS Apparatus Operator–Pump course.

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter on the first day of class. Class size is limited to Fifteen (15) students.
