Passenger Train Emergency Rescue Procedures

This is a 8 hour course being held on the following dates:

September 20 from 19:00 to 22:00 hours

&

September 22 from 08:00 to 13:00 hours @ *Metro North Croton Harmon Train Yard*
(Directions to the yard will be provided to students during class on 9/20)

Description: Partnership between Metro North Railroad and OFPC. Content includes: railroad systems, equipment and procedures; normal and emergency operation of equipment; power systems including locomotives, electric equipment and third rail precautions; search and rescue procedures and victim removal discussion.

Target audience: All emergency response personnel

Prerequisites: Firefighter I; Basic Firefighter; or Firefighting Essentials.

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter on the first day of class. Class size is limited to twenty-five (25) students.

Venue: Westchester County DES Training Center, 4 Dana Rd. – Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York. All students are to park in the lot adjacent to the Support Services Building located at 35 Walker Road. (There is a stairway linking the parking lot directly to the training campus.)
