Fire Police

This is a 21 hour course being held on the following dates:

December 6, 10, 11, 12, 13 from 19:00 to 22:00 hours

December 15 from 08:00 to 14:00 hours

Description: Trains fire police to perform their duties more effectively. It includes defining and interpreting terms, oath of office, relation to regular police officers, general duties, maintaining safe conditions at an emergency, traffic direction and control, pre-planning, and various laws of interest to the fire service. Under the provision of General Municipal Law, Section 209-c, this course, when approved by OFPC, must be completed by every fire police officer who was appointed after September 1, 1980.

Target audience: Fire service personnel designated as fire police

Prerequisites: Any appointed Fire Police Officer or Firefighter authorized by their Chief in any Fire Department in New York State. *Students must be over the age of 18 to attend this course.*

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter on the first day of class. Class size is limited to Thirty (30) students.

Venue: Westchester County DES Training Center, 4 Dana Rd. – Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York.
