Principles of Building Construction: Non-Combustibles

This course is being held on the following dates:

January 15, 17, 29, 31 from 19:00 to 22:00 hours

Description: Introduces special characteristics of noncombustible and fire resistive construction as they concern the fire service. Primary emphasis is on improving the fire officer's ability to ensure firefighter safety by recognizing common causes and indicators of failure and other hazards related to building construction. Course material enables the fire officer to better predict the overall reaction of a building to fire conditions.

Target audience: Fire Service Personnel

Prerequisites: Firefighter I, Basic Exterior Firefighter Operations, or Scene Support Operations

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <http://training.westchestergov.com>. Class size is limited to twenty-five (25) students.
