Firefighter I Refresher Training – Structural Search & Rescue

This is a 6 hour course being held on the following dates:

March 26 & 28 from 19:00 to 22:00 hours

Description: This FF1 refresher training course is intended to continue to build on the skills learned in Firefighter I. The course consists of two 3-hour sessions (1 classroom and one skill session). This course will review search and victim removal methods used during structural search and rescue. Firefighters will review knowledge and conduct training evolutions in the following areas:

- Size-up and Situational Awareness
- Safe guidelines for structural search and rescue
- Primary and secondary search techniques
- Basic search methods and victim removal
- Vent, Enter, Isolate, and Search (VEIS)
- Victim removal options; such as incline drag, webbing drag, lift and carry, and other methods.

Target audience: Firefighters

Prerequisites: NYS Firefighter I (or equivalent)

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter on the first day of class. Class size is limited to Twenty (20) students.
