Firefighter Assist & Search Team (F.A.S.T.)

This 15 hour course is being held on the following dates:

March 5, 7, 12, 19 from 18:30 to 22:30 hours

Description: The firefighter as a member of a FAST operation will identify the tools and staffing requirements for a FAST operation, develop a rescue plan for a missing, lost, or trapped firefighter; demonstrate rope search techniques, and demonstrate removing a firefighter/victim up a stairwell, up or down through a hole in a floor/roof, moving a downed firefighter down a ladder. This course requires students to perform a number of practical evolutions with self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA).

Target audience: Fire service personnel.

Prerequisites: Firefighter Survival, Firefighter – I (or equivalent), SCBA medical clearance, NYS Training Authorization Letter.

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter which can be accessed and downloaded when registering. Class size is limited to eighteen (18) students.

Venue: Westchester County DES Training Center, 4 Dana Rd. – Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York. All students are to park in the lot adjacent to the Support Services Building located at 35 Walker Road. (There is a stairway linking the parking lot directly to the training campus.)
