Apparatus Operator – Emergency Vehicle Operations

April 29, May 6, 8 from 19:00 to 22:00 hours
May 12 from 08:00 to 17:00 hours

Description: Provides vehicle operators with a better understanding of the seriousness of emergency vehicle operations. Based on objectives from National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 1002 Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator, Chapter 2, this course stimulates the thought processes to make students aware of the potential for tragedy and financial loss and of the legal and moral responsibilities encountered when operating an emergency vehicle.

Target audience: Fire Service Personnel

Prerequisites: Firefighter I, Scene Support Operations, or Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations and a valid driver's license. Must be over the age of 18 years old.

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter. Class size is limited to Fifteen (15) students.

Venue: Westchester County DES Training Center, 4 Dana Rd. – Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York. All students are to park in the lot adjacent to the [Support Services Building](#) located at 35 Walker Road. (There is a stairway linking the parking lot directly to the training campus.)
