Firefighter II

This is a 42 hour course being held on the following dates:

May 13, 15, 20, 29, June 5, 12 from 19:00 to 22:00 hours

May 22, 28, June 3, 10, 17, 19 from 18:30 to 22:30 hours

Description: The NYS DHSES OFPC Firefighter 2 course is designed to meet the N.F.P.A 1001 Chapter 6 for Firefighter 2. The classroom contact is 42 hours and requires online homework assignments. The firefighter 2 candidate will acquire skills that will allow them to operate them as a member of a team under general supervision. The completion of the course requires the prerequisite firefighter 1 and will allow them to meet the criteria to sit for National Certification. Some of the required skills will include; Accident Victim Extrication Training, Specialized Team Awareness, Foam and Flammable Gas Fire Suppression, Hose Testing, Evidence Preservation, Public Education, ICS and Coordinated Fire Attack, Size Up and Communications. **The online coursework is encouraged to be completed in advance of the class.**

Target audience: Interior Firefighters

Prerequisites: Firefighter I or equivalent

Registration: Pre-registration is mandatory. **WALK-INS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** To register go to <https://training.westchestergov.com/training/login.do>. Each student must present a NYS Training Authorization Letter on the first day of class. Class size is limited to Twenty (20) students.

Venue: Westchester County DES Training Center, 4 Dana Rd. – Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York. All students are to park in the lot adjacent to the Support Services Building located at 35 Walker Road. (There is a stairway linking the parking lot directly to the training campus.)

Full PPE and SCBA will be required.

New York State Authorization form is MANDATORY for Admission to class
