ABCs, MARCHE, BATH, Lessons learned from the battlefield can make a difference between life and death in our communities. Assessing MOI, AMS, and possible multi-system trauma, and performing blood sweeps in a methodical way to assess and treat life threats are all pieces to a good rapid trauma assessment. (Students that have been issued or own an IFAK are encouraged to bring them to class) \*To ensure the safety of the students, firearms, knives, pepper spray, or Tasers are not permitted\*
