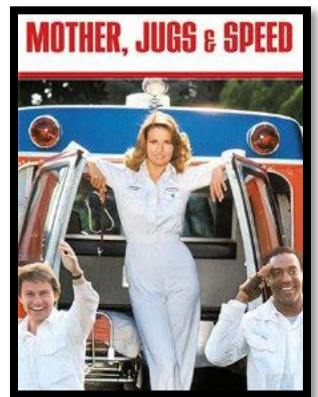
Dinner & Movie
