Thermal Imaging Camera Training

Description:

Firefighters will receive hands-on instruction using their department's thermal imager in live fire training. This experience provides firefighters with intense, individualized instruction. This training session will give firefighters the basic knowledge and confidence required to use this high-tech tool effectively and safely in the field. Firefighters will better understand and feel comfortable with their thermal imager.

Full PPE and SCBA are REQUIRED. Students should plan to bring one of their department's thermal imaging cameras.

Target audience: Interior Firefighters

Prerequisites:

- Firefighter I or equivalent
