The Engine Company Pump Operator - "Tank to Pump - Then What?"

Description:

Most members complete their initial pump class and are cleared to drive and operate an engine apparatus. Often those classes are filled with math, pump theory, and non-practical pumping scenarios. "Tank to Pump Then What" is modular series designed to build confidence and skill needed to operate as pump operator. The basic mission of the Engine Company Chauffeur is to get the apparatus on scene safely and start water in a handline. The Chauffeur arrives on scene positions the apparatus, places the engine in pump, pulls the tank to pump then what? This 12-hour county level class address the following topics:

- Short Classroom Session
- Street Friction Loss and Calculations
- Fire Commander/ Pump governor
- Primer System
- Positioning the apparatus on a hydrant (All operations in the 1st class with be in proximity to the hydrant)
- Pumping 1 handline from tank
- Securing Positive water
- Transition to positive water
- Pumping multiple Handlines
- Water Loss Emergencies
- Fireground Radio Operations

Target audience: Fire Service Personnel

Prerequisites:

- *Pump Operator and/or current Engine Company Chauffeur*
