Description:

Westchester’s weekly drill series is designed to enhance the skillset of Fire Service personnel operating at a wide range of incident types. The drills will run one evening per week and rotate between four broad subject areas: Engine, Truck, Rescue/EMS, and Command/Leadership. The series is designed to supplement your department’s training schedule while providing attendees with proven drills they can bring back home. Each drill is purpose-built to benefit everyone, from the entry-level firefighter to the experienced chief officer.
