Drills will be conducted during the week and will rotate through key subject areas. Through a combination of discussion-based learning and hands on training, this program empowers firefighters and officers to both initiate and facilitate daily drills at their home departments. Each session is thoughtfully designed to supplement your departments existing training schedule, while providing practical drills that participants can take back and implement.

Hydra-Ram Use

Join us for an in-depth training session on the hydra-ram, a hydraulically operated forcible entry tool designed for power, efficiency, and portability. The hydra-ram is a powerful yet lightweight tool that has its time and place on the fireground. While it is an effective addition to our forcible entry capabilities, it does not replace conventional forcible entry methods, it complements them.

This class will cover:

- Proper positioning techniques
- Application on the fireground
- Hands-on training
- Inspection, care, and maintenance procedures
